- Kindly be informed that as per the new entry visa regulations, all travelers, individuals and groups, arriving to any Syrian ports should be having two copies of the first four pages of their passports. Adherence with the above regulation shall avoid you any delay resultant from having your passport copied upon arrival.

Important Note

A visa or stamp to Israel or the self- ruled territories, used or unused / valid or invalid, will lead to an immediate entry refusal at all Syrian/Lebanese ports of entry, even if the traveler is carrying a valid entry visa, and even if s/he is traveling on a group visa

Tourist Visa Regulations

We can arrange single entry visa at any Syrian port of entry, provided that the following passport details are sent to Nawafir at least 10 working days prior to client's arrival:

- **Full name**
- **Date of birth**
- **Place of birth**
- **Passport number**
- **Date of issue**
- **Place of issue**
- **Expiration date**
- **Nationality**
- **Profession**

Passports should be valid for a minimum of 6 months after departure date.

Procedures:

- our licensed representative/guide shall await the clients upon arrival at the Immigration counter to handle their entry visa
- our licensed representative/guide shall escort the clients upon departure to handle their exit visa
