Hotel Overview

Since 1892, the Bristol has represented the cosmopolitan hub of Viennese social, cultural and business life, combining its rich past with its contemporary comforts. Floor-to-ceiling gilt-framed mirrors hang at every landing of the hotel's immense staircases. Corridors are studded with Art Nouveau leadlighting and the lift is lined with marble and leather. The lobby lounge has marble columns, chandeliers and oil paintings, and is scattered with plump Biedemeyer armchairs and marble coffee tables. Palms in brass pots provide privacy for guests reading American, German and Japanese newspapers. This hotel has 140 guestrooms, all of which are furnished with antiques and hung with period oil paintings. Pale wood furnishings with black geometric inlays provide an Art Nouveau ambience, softened by brocaded bedspreads and romantic throw-cushions.

LOCATION

Hotel Bristol is centrally located opposite the Vienna State Opera House and near famous city sights. It is located by the famous Stadtpark and just a few minutes short walk from the Ringstraße and the renowned shopping area of Kaerntner Strasse.

PROPERTY AMENITIES

- * Korso bei der Oper: The Michelin-starred Korso serves European and regional Austrian cuisine at lunch and dinner. In the serene, elegant dining room, guests sit in deep, green armchairs at pink-linen-clad tables. Palms and period screens provide privacy.
- * Restaurant Sirk: Specializing in Austrian cuisine, Sirk's modern dining room has clean lines, angular furnishings, and overlooks the State Opera house. The walls are hung with photos of the opera stars who have dined here. Sirk serves lunch and dinner, a breakfast buffet and family buffets on Sundays.
- * Cafe Sirk: Cafe Sirk caters to hotel guests and passing Viennese residents. This street-level coffee house is furnished with black-and-orange bistro chairs and serves light lunch and dinner as well as traditional Viennese cakes and coffee.
- * Bristol Bar: The Bristol Bar was the first American-style bar in Vienna. The bar's deep, green armchairs, snug corners, and antique racing prints give it a living-room feel. The green leather barstools which line up by the small bar are as likely to seat Viennese businessmen as hotel guests.
- * The light-flooded Ringstrassen Salons string together like the pearls of a necklace and an atmosphere of noble elegance blends with the latest conference technology in the oval Mezzanine and Souterrain Salons. Major conventions and seminars as well as festive banquets take place at the Festive Hall. The dignified atmosphere of the EU Board Room is made for small, yet exquisite meetings.

ROOM AMENITIES

- * This hotel has 140 guestrooms, all of which are furnished with antiques and hung with period oil paintings. Pale wood furnishings with black geometric inlays provide an Art Nouveau ambience, softened by brocaded bedspreads and romantic throw-cushions. Some rooms have decorative fireplaces, others have a view of the State Opera House.
- * Every guest arrives to a fruit basket and mineral water. All rooms have dial-up Internet access. Bathrooms are lined with marble and each has scales and bathrobes.
