Lunch at **Roast** – stylishly nestled within a landmark London building above gourmet Borough Market, a culinary and deliciously British treat awaits.

Spend the afternoon sampling some of the newest developments for shopping in London. Options include: **Covent Garden** and **Seven Dials** –

Covent Garden has recently been transformed, in conjunction with the **Royal Opera House** located next to the main square. Nearby Seven Dials is one of London's newest shopping destinations, described by Harpers and Queen as "London's freshest style hot spot" with new stores opening regularly.

Carnaby Street and Kingly Court – opened in June 2003, this three-level shopping area looking out onto a stylish piazza features new shops such as Red Dot, Evisu and Zoltar the Magnificent.

Westfield – The largest in town shopping centre in Europe, the Westfield is simply one of the best places in London to shop. Best of British Luxury Shopping



The list of great British shops is of course enormous, and a simple way of finding great UK brands is to visit one of London's premium department stores. An excellent starting point would be **Selfridges**, where from the ground floor up you will find examples of superb British goods. For fragrances try **Penhaligon's** and **Floris**, for handbags there is **Mulberry**, for lingerie try **Agent Provocateur** and for fashion head for **Stella McCartney** and **Alexander McQueen**. The food halls of **Harrods**, **Selfridges** and **Fortnum & Mason** offer the finest comestibles such as Scottish smoked salmon, Twinings tea or even Gordon's gin. It is an endless list...

Turnbull and Asser

The original Jermyn Street shirt maker, **Turnbull & Asser** has dressed among others Winston Churchill, Prince Charles and even Al Pacino. However the appeal of these distinctive shirts is not just the extensive royal and celebrity clientele but also the superb cut and quality.

Vivienne Westwood

The pioneer of the punk look, the amazing **Vivienne Westwood** is now part of the international fashion elite and has become something of a national treasure. Her designs are immediately recognisable for their immaculate cut, eccentric design and voluminous use of fabric, which is frequently her trademark tartan.

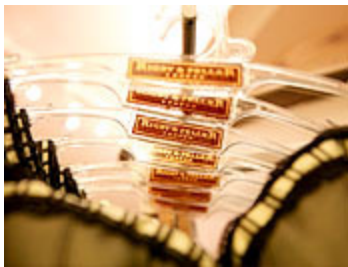
Temperley
