Ceremonies in the popular Italy wedding locations for foreign citizens are performed in Italian with an English translation - making it easy for couples from abroad. Often a section will be in Italian - then repeated in English by the official conducting the ceremony. Couples from abroad wishing to get married in Italy are welcomed by the Italian authorities!

Civil and Religious weddings are both available for couples from outside Italy. In most countries, Civil weddings usually take place in bland government buildings, but in Italy, Civil weddings take place in grand palaces or historic villas owned by the local government of the area. In Rome you can get married the magnificent Campidoglio which was designed by Michelangelo. In Venice you can marry overlooking the Grand Canal from a beautiful palace. Exchange your vows from a ornate villa overlooking Europe's most beautiful views on the Amalfi Coast. Why not arrive by boat at a villa on a the placid Lake Como - with views of medieval ancient castles?

As you would expect from a nation with the world's finest architecture, Church weddings & other religious weddings also have many magnificent locations. The choices for a wedding in Italy just go on and on. The range of options for a Italian wedding is truly spectacular. Choosing which location you want to get married in Italy will certainly be your biggest problem!

Getting married in Italy need not be as difficult as it sounds. With some good advice & direction,

plus understanding what type of wedding you want, you really can have an fantastic Italian wedding which you and your guests will never forget.



### **Italian wedding ceremonies** **Wedding locations Italy**

Civil Ceremonies must take place in a Town Hall or property purchased by the local government. Typically very grand locations are available such as palaces, villas and manors. To Italians, with their amazing architecture, only beautiful buildings in their towns and cities are the settings that are approved for civil ceremonies.

Do not be concerned about ending up in a cold government building, most Town Halls are simply stunning and in wonderful surroundings. As with all the architecture in Italy, you will not be disappointed with the choices on offer. Yet again, due to the many beautiful locations that stretch across Italy for a wedding ceremony, deciding where to get married in Italy is really your biggest problem!

You can marry in either a civil or religious ceremony in Italy. Due to the limited residency requirements, you can virtually get married in any town in Italy. However, if you wanted a location that has little experience with foreigners you may encounter some difficulties. Fortunately, the most spectacular locations are often welcoming to couples from overseas & have all the experience to simplify the procedure.

It is best to understand the rules and regulations that make each type of ceremony legal in Italy. Some of the rules regarding a civil ceremony are:

A local civil official must perform the marriage.



The marriage cannot be performed on the premise of an foreign embassy or consulate.

In a religious ceremony:

If a Roman Catholic priest is performing the marriage, you do not need to get married first in a civil ceremony; however, the priest must register the marriage with the civil registrar in order for the marriage to be legal. If you are non-Roman Catholic, a prior civil ceremony is usually required to ensure the legality of the marriage.

It is also possible to arrange a Jewish wedding in Italy.

If you are considering getting married in Italy, you may want to consider professional wedding consultants in Italy who can assist you with all the necessary paperwork and logistics. There are many companies in Italy, and a few in your own country. Prices vary widely.

For a little extra work you can organise your own wedding and save money.



### **Italy wedding paperwork How to get married legally in Italy**

You will have to prepare some paperwork before the wedding at home. The precise details you will require varies upon where you are from and your legal status. Getting married in Italy is not as easy as some countries, but it can be done. Many couples have done it from all over the world - so many of the hurdles have already been set aside.

Basically, to legally get married in Italy you will need to provide:

- Formal proof that you are single is required.

If applicable, evidence of the termination of any previous marriage such as final divorce decree, annulment decree or death certificate.

- If under 18, a Sworn Statement by parents or legal guardian consenting to the marriage.

- 'Atto Notorio'. This is a declaration stating that according to your country's laws, there is no obstacle to your marriage.

A woman whose previous marriage was terminated within the last 300 days must obtain a waiver from the Procura della Repubblica (District Attorney), which is issued on presentation of a medical certificate that she is not pregnant!

***Civil Ceremonies***

Civil weddings in Italy can only be performed in a Registry Office, most are located in a town hall in historical buildings and offer a lovely setting for a wedding. Most registry offices in Italy require you to sign a declaration of Intent to Marry up to 4 days before your wedding ceremony.

***Symbolic & Commitment Ceremonies***

For those who do not want to or can not hold a formal civil or religious wedding with all the legal paperwork, a blessing may represent a beautiful alternative. It is often very similar to many other kinds of weddings, the difference being that it is not legally binding. As it is more symbolic, no paperwork is required and there are no restrictions on the locations.

## Sorrento Weddings

Perched atop the rocky cliffs on a beautiful headland is Sorrento boasting wonderful views over the gulf of Naples and Mount Vesuvius. Civil ceremonies in Sorrento take place in the Moorish-style Cloisters of San Francesco in the historical centre of Sorrento, part of which dates back to the 8th century. The civil ceremony will be performed in Italian by the Civil Registrar and translated into English by a local interpreter.

Weddings at the Town Hall Cloisters are conducted from Monday to Friday from 11am to 1pm and Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 3.30pm to 5.30pm, on the hour.

\*\*It is also possible to have your wedding on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday afternoons at an extra supplement from €300.

## Florence Weddings

The capital city of Tuscany, set in beautiful and serene countryside, Florence was at the heart of the Renaissance. The room is situated in the Florence Town Hall - the Palazzo Vecchio which has always been and still is the symbolic centre of the town. Your civil wedding ceremony will take place in the Town Hall in Italian by a Civil Registrar and translated into English by a local interpreter.



Civil wedding ceremonies are held on Wednesday and Thursday mornings and Saturdays upon request for a supplement. The Town Hall should be visited a few days before the wedding.

## Lake Garda Weddings

There is also a Castle tower which is suitable for eight people. The main ceremony room has been recently refurbished in a modern style with a parquet floor and seats 30 to 40 people.

## Venice Weddings

Civil weddings in Venice are conducted at the Town Hall Palazzo Cavalla, once a private Palace near to Rialto Bridge and just a few minutes from St Marks Square, and one of the most famous wedding locations in Italy. An elegant entrance, formal hall with balcony and original 18 th Century paintings overlooking the Grand Canal and the Rialto Bridge make this a unique wedding location. Your civil wedding ceremony will take place in the Town Hall in Italian by the Civil Registrar and translated into English by a local interpreter.

Civil weddings in Venice are arranged in the morning, between Monday and Friday. Afternoon or weekend weddings may be possible at a supplement.

## Verona Weddings

Standing on the banks of the Adige is Verona, a small city with a huge amount of history and romance. Romeo and Juliet were immortalised by Shakespeare and on Thursdays and Saturdays, romantic weddings are celebrated at 'Juliet's memorial'. You will need to visit the Registrars Office two days prior to the wedding which will be followed by a romantic ceremony in a beautiful villa where 'Juliet's memorial' is housed - the Tapestry Hall of the main wedding Palace by the Roman Arena. The interior is intimate and overlooks the garden and trellised walkways. Your civil wedding ceremony will take place in Italian by the Civil Registrar and translated into English by a local interpreter.

On the first Saturday of the month weddings are conducted in the Tapestry Hall. The Town Hall should be visited a few days before the wedding.

## Amalfi & Ravello weddings

Amalfi is the main town on the coast and lies at the foot of Monte Cerreto surrounded by dramatic cliffs and coastal scenery. Wedding ceremonies take place in the beautiful Salone Morelli which contains important documents and furnishings of the Maritime Republic and the civil ceremony is conducted in Italian by the Civil Registrar and translated into English by a local interpreter.

Best known for its dominant coastal views, Ravello is about 15 minutes drive inland from Amalfi. This small aristocratic town is in an elevated position with some of the best views of the coast and still relatively uncommercialised with a lovely main square, a handful of shops and historic villas. Your civil wedding ceremony will take place in the Town Hall in Italian by the Civil Registrar and translated into English by a local interpreter.

Weddings can be held Monday to Friday in the mornings. The Town Hall should be visited a few days before.

## Catholic weddings

Catholic wedding ceremonies follow a traditional Italian Catholic format with some degree of flexibility for personal readings and music. Catholic weddings are available in the following locations:

**Tuscany :** Fiesole, Certaldo, Siena, San Gimignano, Pisa, Pietrasanta, Arezzo and Volterra.

**Lake Garda :** Sirmione, Bardolino, Castelletto and the Valpolicella area.

**Lake Como :** Varenna.

**NB** All locations are at the discretion of the parish priest as to whether he will allow the wedding to be celebrated for non residents even in areas where the Bishop allows them.

- Music - Ceremonies can include live musicians, such as a harpist, organist, a string quartet or typical Neapolitan musicians. For a reception we can arrange either live musicians or a DJ, the choice of music will be up to you.
- Photographic Services - The photographers are experienced in studio, portrait & wedding photography. Packages can include 20-30 colour photos, an album and negatives. Digital options, black & white and sepia may all be available, along with leather bound albums. A video or DVD may also be available which include music and editing.



**This document provides detailed wedding regulations for Italy and offers many venues.**

**IMPORTANT -**

- No Residency Requirements -
- Outdoor Weddings Are Legal - Also, unlike most of Italy and Europe, outdoor weddings are legal - except for Catholic weddings which must be held in a church.
- The date on the marriage certificate for non-Catholic weddings (civil and religious) will be the date when the official documents are signed at the town hall. For most couples, this is usually the date of the outdoor ceremony; but some couples find it more convenient to go to the town hall a day or two prior to the outdoor ceremony.
- There are common Italian marriage laws; however, each region interprets these laws differently and adds some restriction of their own - e.g., some have a minimum of 6 to 10 day stay requirement. This can cause confusion. If you are in doubt, contact your consulate in Italy - email us for specific consulate contact information.

- Musicians will play for around one hour for ceremony packages, around three to four hours for some reception packages. Classical music for receptions would just be about 2 hours.
- Clients that prefer to provide their own music for ceremony and/or reception will require special permission from the church/hotel/venue. Note: Taxes for non-classical music will still be required to be paid ahead of time.
